**Indication:**

Limited compression ultrasonography of the  **RIGHT**  **LEFT** lower extremity was performed to evaluate for non-compressibility of the common femoral vein (CFV), superficial femoral vein (SFV), and/or popliteal vein (PV) in the patient. The ultrasound was performed with the following indications, as noted in the H&P:

- Lower extremity pain
- Lower extremity swelling
- Chest pain
- Dyspnea
- Tachypnea
- Other indications as noted in the H&P

**Identified structures:**

**RIGHT**  **LEFT** CFV, SFV, and PV were examined.

**Findings:** Exam of the above structures revealed the following findings:

- Right CFV:  good compressibility  non-compressible
- Right SFV:  good compressibility  non-compressible
- Right Popliteal vein:  good compressibility  non-compressible
- Left CFV:  good compressibility  non-compressible
- Left SFV:  good compressibility  non-compressible
- Left Popliteal vein:  good compressibility  non-compressible
